Classroom Update

Language Arts: Students read “Jalapeno Bagels,” the last story in our unit, Our Country and Its People. This fictional piece introduces students to Pablo. Pablo’s parents run a bakery together. His mother, who is Mexican, is famous for her *pan dulce* and *empanada de calabaza*. His father, who is Jewish, is an expert at making bagels. When Pablo and his classmates are instructed to bring something from their culture to share with the class, Pablo brings the jalapeno bagels that his parents make. He explains that the bagels are mixture of his two parents, just like he is. Vocabulary words to review include: **jalapeno, ingredients, dough, knead, recipe, and mixture.**

Math: Students will identify missing addends; write numbers to a thousand; and add/subtract multiples of 10.

Second Grade Mall: This is a culminating activity for our final social studies unit, economics. Take a deep breath... The second grade mall is kid and parent friendly. We will limit the amount of homework, allowing time for students to work in their groups to create products to “sell” at the mall.
