




Homework:

Classroom Update

Language Arts: Students will read, "Come Back, Jack!" the second story in our Sharing Stories unit. In this lively story, a young boy named Jack helps his sister discover the joys of reading by actually entering a storybook. His adventures in the storybook blend together the experiences of four other well-known storybook Jacks: Jack, Jill's friend; Jack, the nimble candlestick jumper; Jack, who built a house; and Jack who met a giant on top of a beanstalk. New vocabulary works include: **boring, adventure, exciting, searched,**

steep, and **nimble**. This week, students will illustrate one of these vocabulary words, name the part of speech, and write the word in a sentence. What is your favorite childhood story? Please share with your child.

Read Aloud: Students are listening to the Core Literature novel, *Ramona the Pest* by Beverly Cleary. Our million dollar vocabulary words are: **coaxed, grubby,** and **seized.** Challenge your child to use these words in conversation.

Math: This week students will learn addition facts: doubles +1, identify geometric shape pieces that differ in one way, tell time to the half hour, estimate temperature, read a thermometer to the nearest 10 degrees, and count dimes and pennies.

Writing Workshop: This week's focus will be on fixing, editing, and fancying up our writing in preparation for our author's celebration.

Class Hop with Mrs. Herbert – Social Studies: Last week students discussed why government leaders make laws and why judges, police officers, and other citizens carry out laws or punish wrongdoers. Students discussed elections and the importance of democracy. They also identified the characteristics and duties of community, state, and national leaders. Words to review: vote, election, ballot, judge, and law.

Class Hop with Ms. Ibrahim/Ms. Carlin - Science: Last week students worked with simple machines: levers, pulleys, ramps/incline planes, screws, wheels and axels, and wedges. Challenge your students to find examples of these simple machines around your house. Students also continued to discuss gravity, mass, and the forces of push and pull.

Class Hop with Ms. Kinnier – Social Studies: Last week students dove into the deep ocean of geography and learned the names of the continents. Vocabulary: North America, South America, Europe, Asia, Australia, and Antarctica.

Mind Up: Once a week, second graders are taking part in the MindUP™ program from the Beach Cities Health District. MindUp is a signature education initiative designed to help students manage their emotions and behaviors, reduce stress, sharpen concentration and increase empathy and optimism, which cultivates well-being and emotional balance. This better prepares them for success, both inside the classroom and out.
